
CHILDREN'S BELL CHOIR

NAZARENE COMPASSIONATE MINISTRIES

Arabic TV Program Teaches Holiness

PRAISE: A TV program called *Follow Me* is the sixth television program produced by Nazarene Broadcast Communication Ministries. Host Ayman Kafrouny directs and produces the program with a team of Nazarenes, most of whom are members of the Church of the Nazarene in Beirut, Lebanon, where he serves as lead pastor. Kafrouny observed that few Christian programs in Arabic focused on a clear understanding of holiness; he and his team set out to fill that void. "Our hope, our prayer is to reach out to people who we cannot see face to face," Kafrouny said. "The results, the fruits, we may not see them all. We believe the people we are reaching, that many are becoming [citizens] in the Kingdom of God."

M19 Conference

PRAISE: M19 is scheduled for 11-13 February 2019 in Kansas City, Missouri, USA. The mid-quadrennial conference for Nazarenes on the USA/Canada Region emphasizes mission and evangelism. Leaders will receive opportunities for training, encouragement, and networking, through plenary sessions, workshops, exhibits, worship, and instruction. The theme for the 2019 event is "The Mission: The Gospel Unleashed."
