#### Bolivia Conference Encourages Youth

**PRAISE:** The Bolivia Nazarene Youth International (NYI) and Bolivian National Communications Ministry teams organized a national youth conference called Despertar 19 (Awakening 19) in late June. Approximately 200 youth from the six Bolivia districts attended the event, which was also broadcast live on the Bolivia NYI Facebook page. Workshops offered tools to develop a contemporary youth ministry, and the event also included worship services and a call for participants to reach the youth of Bolivia. Give thanks for this event that reached the Bolivian Nazarene youth, and pray as plans begin for another national youth event on a different district in 2022.

#### Boat Ministry Reaches Isolated Communities

**PRAISE:** Brazil's Amazon District Superintendent Jean Norgueira led a boating evangelism team on their first trip of the year down the Baixo River to reach isolated communities. The team members were from the Church of the Nazarene in Manaus. More than 200 communities are situated along the river, and there is no church or other access to the gospel, making Manaus a very promising evangelism hub. The district Nazarene Missions International and a church on the district helped provide the *JESUS* film and materials translated into the languages of the area. These gifts will allow the church to continue evangelism and church planting along the Baixo River. Give thanks for the Brazil Amazon District's passion to reach the lost and pray as they begin planning the next phase of evangelism and church planting.
