Cuba Church of the Nazarene released the names of the pastor couples killed in the May 18th crash of Cubana Flight 972. They also confirmed that the 10th couple, previously not among the government's list of deceased, was in fact on the plane and both individuals passed away. Among those listed are the Cuba East District's Nazarene Missions International president, secretary, and treasurer.

The couples were at a 3-day National Conference in Havana, returning home to the Province of Holguín.
